Entry Details:

- Show is for DRA members only
- Submit any type of visual art or installation piece (contact curator for large or unusual pieces) keeping with a "blue" theme.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork; DRA members are entitled to have at least one piece of art displayed if all submission criteria are met. Acceptance is at the Curator's discretion.
- Pieces must be ready to hang (with screw eyes and wire) or ready for display (with mounting and/or a display stand if necessary) or ready for installation (to the wall or ceiling).
- Entry fees: \$10 for up to 3 hanging or display pieces; \$10 additional for each installation piece (up to a maximum of 3 pieces total per artist).
- Artists may enter art not for sale (NFS) or priced to sell. When art sells, artist makes a 20% tax deductible donation to Del Ray Artisans.
- Email an Artist Statement to the Curator for each piece of artwork you drop off.
- Email an Artist Bio to the Curator before the show begins.
- Peoples' Choice awards—viewers attach "stars" next to their favorite entries.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, and delivery of sold work.
- ALL artists MUST gallery sit. A sign-up sheet is available at Artwork Receiving.
- The show closes on Sunday, November 21. All artists MUST pick up their remaining artwork from the gallery between 6 and 8 pm on November 21.

Fine Print:

- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
