

CALL FOR ENTRY / ALL MEMBER SHOW

Retakes and Transformations: Art from everyday life

September 2 – October 2, 2011

We invite you to look deeply at your everyday life—to be inspired by delving into your habits, routines, favorite things or surroundings. Retakes: Choose subjects such as your morning coffee, bicycle, walking the dog, petting the cat, sweeping the front porch, bowl of fruit, mobile phone, favorite chair, etc. Transformations: Consider gathering commonplace materials and found objects, and give these familiar items new life through art. Reveal the details in 2D or 3D and in any medium.

Also consider entering the “*Art for everyday life*” market. Perfect for fine handcraft artisans to submit work—the elegant bowl, wacky serving spoon, modern platter, flirty handbag, etc. Shrink-wrapped, unframed, matted 2D artwork is also encouraged for the market.

Entry Details:

- This show is open to Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members only.
- Receiving takes place Sunday August 28 from 7-9pm and Monday August 29 from 7-9pm.
- Artists may submit up to 2 pieces of artwork for the show. Show entry fee is \$4 per piece.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork for the market. Work may be fine handcrafts or shrink-wrapped 2D art (no larger than 18”x24”) for cash-and-carry sales. Market entry fee is \$2 per piece. These works must be for sale.
- DRA members are entitled to have at least one piece displayed in the show if all submission criteria are met. Acceptance of all submissions is at the curator’s discretion.
- Your art – except market entries – must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for more information.
- Diptychs or triptychs that are framed as 2 or 3 separate framed pieces will count as 2 or 3 separate entries; only if the diptych or triptych is framed as one piece will it be accepted as a single entry.
- Buyers will be allowed to pick up market artwork immediately (cash-and-carry) and show artwork any time during the last two days of the show: Saturday October 1 (*Art on the Avenue*) and Sunday October 2.
- When your art sells you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax-deductable) to *Del Ray Artisans*.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, as well as delivery of sold work.
- **All artists MUST gallery sit and/or volunteer** with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. You are also asked to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- After the entries are accepted for the show or market, artists may not pick up unsold artwork until Sunday October 2 from 6-8pm.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
