Call for Entry – Open To All Area Artists

April 5 – 28, 2013

Take an opportunity to pay homage to your favorite master, question the hoopla surrounding particular pieces and praise, critique, or dish the artist and peers who have influenced us.

Satire can be the biggest compliment to a master artist and highly encouraged for this show, but works that pay homage to your master are also encouraged... Who do you consider a master?.....A master may be from any era or even current day. A picture of your selected master/master artwork will be displayed next to selected artwork, so you must **include a 4"X6" color or black and white photo-quality picture of your master/master's artwork**. Show is open to both 2- and 3-dimensional art as well as textiles. Please contact the curators if you plan on submitting any large pieces of artwork.

We are honored to introduce our Show Awarding Judge: Scott Brooks.

Entry Details:

- This show is open to All Area Artists.
- Receiving takes place Sunday March 31, 6-8pm and Monday April 1, 5-7pm.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for Del Ray Artisans' members and \$8 per piece for non-members. Each Artwork must be accompanied by a 4"X6" photo-quality copy of the "Master/Master Work" that inspired the artwork. **Artwork must be priced to sell.**
- Each artist is also invited to submit 2 pieces of take-away art for an additional entry fee of \$1 per artwork for members and \$2 per artwork for non-members.
- Show Awards (Best in Show, 1st, 2nd and 3rd) will be selected by Judge Scott Brooks.
- Artist will be notified by email on April 3 if their artwork was not selected.
- **DISPLAY GUIDELINES:** All 2D art must be hang read (wire/screw eyes; no clip frames) and matted and framed. All 3-D art must be submitted with proper devises for hanging or with a display easel. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.thedelrayartisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for guidelines.
- When your art sells you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax-deductible) to *Del Ray Artisans*.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, as well as delivery of sold work if the gallery is unable to arrange pick-up. Entries that are accepted into this art exhibit must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit. This includes sold and unsold artwork.
- All artists **MUST** gallery host and/or volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendar to **artwork receiving, so you can sign up for duties. We'll ask you to contribute a food or beverage** for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for DRA publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
