### ALTARS: Religious Rituals

What comes to mind when you think of altars? They could reflect places of heavenly worship or nether worldly sacrifice. They can be simple raised platforms or elaborate structures used for religious ceremonies. Whether you think of them literally such as for worship or sacrifice, or figuratively for things given priority at the cost of something else—perhaps work over family—altars are used in varying religious rituals around the world. Del Ray Artisans (DRA) and Art Latin American Collective Project (ALACP) have teamed up to present this unique artistic challenge to their members. Artists, dig deep into your imaginations! Explore the use of altars in religious rituals worldwide and create your interpretations in any and every form of media.

##### *Open to DRA & ALACP members only*

- Artwork receiving is Sunday, August 30<sup>th</sup> & Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> from 6-8pm
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. The entry fee for DRA & ALACP members is \$5 per piece. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- All artwork must be for sale. Any pieces marked at “NFS” will **not** be accepted.
- Artwork must be ready to hang and display, with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. #### Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements.
- **All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer** with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. We'll ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork is the responsibility of the artist. Del Ray Artisans, Art Latin American Collective Project, and the City of Alexandria cannot be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a Del Ray Artisans show.
- When your art sells, you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax- deductible) to Del Ray Artisans.
- Any artwork left over 30 days after the close of the show will become property of Del Ray Artisans.
- Print out and keep a copy of this call for entry form for your records.
