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Workshop-Creating Works for Commissions

Workshop by Elizabeth Busch. Presented by Studio Art Quilts Associates (SAQA) VA/NC/SC Region

"Designing for Architectural Spaces" Level: intermediate

For any artist interested in doing commission work.

Elizabeth Busch is a visual artist from Maine. She is an amazing source of knowledge regarding the commission process and installing art.

Ms. Busch writes: Most of my income is from doing large scale work that is commissioned for public spaces. It is remarkable how many opportunities are out there to do big work! This workshop is for the person who is ready to learn about doing commissions, both public and private. Even if you are just

beginning to think about the possibility of doing this kind of work, in 5 days you will have attained the tools to enter a competition and/or submit a proposal for a private commission.

Each person will learn how to read an architect's scale, read blueprints and build a small model (maquette) of an assigned space. We will discuss working with architects and committees, developing and writing a proposal, cost and time estimates, etc. This is a nuts and bolts workshop, literally a semester's work in 5 days! And amazingly, lots of fun!


