Alexandria Art Market Gears Up For Its Second Season

Del Ray Artisans is embarking on our second season of the Alexandria Art Market...your monthly dose of Art in Del Ray.

Due to last year's incredible success we have expanded the market to host 25 artists and have extended the market an extra month!



Our monthly outdoor art market will give DRA members an opportunity to sell their original handmade art work and provide them with consistent exposure to the community.

There will be 6 monthly markets on the first Saturday of the month: May 7, June 4, July 2, August 6, September 3, and November 5, 2011, all 10 am – 4 pm.

Diverse musical performances and food purveyors are scheduled each month.

Art space fee is \$35 per market or \$30 per market if you commit to 3 or more market days. The art market is held on the lawn area around the DRA gallery. Ten percent of each artist's sales from each market are due to DRA.

Each artist will be assigned a 10' X 10' space. Each artist is responsible for providing their own tent, tables, chairs, and displays. Artists who sign up for 3 or more markets will be assigned a permanent space. The outdoor art market will be held rain or shine.

Drawing the Clothed Figure with Alice Kale

WORKSHOP: Sunday, April 3

Students will practice drawing the clothed model in a simplified manner intended to express the underlying human form. Initial gesture drawings will help students to understand and quickly capture a pose. We will then progress into a fully developed drawing of the clothed figure. All skill levels welcome.

The drawing session will run from 1-4 pm. We will have refreshments and a group discussion on what we learned during the session for those who would like to stay on from 4-5 pm.

Please bring newsprint (18"x24"), a fat Sharpie pen and a charcoal pencil. You may bring more drawing materials of your choice, better quality drawing paper, or a portable easel.
