Shades of White kicks off the New Year with an artistic challenge to create artwork using only different shades of white. In 1951, artist Robert Rauschenberg scandalized the art community with his series of white paintings, proving that white isn't "just white". Curators Betsy Mead and Hillary Mead challenge DRA artists to go beyond Rauschenberg's work in their creative process by remembering the myriad hues and tones that make "white". They were to consider reactions that may occur in mixing or firing white pigments. The only restriction — artists had to use various shades of white in creating their artwork.

"Shades of White" Fused Glass Plate Workshop (Jan. 14 & Jan. 21)

Artist Betsy Mead will show you that "white isn't just white". She will use two shades of white glass to create an 8" x 8" plate that, when fused, can have shades of black, brown, grey, or blue. 2-part workshop: Mondays, January 14 and January 21, 10 am - Noon, at the gallery. Open Life Drawing in 2013

Looking for a chance to hone your figure drawing skills at the gallery? DRA offers a range of open life drawing sessions. These sessions are drop-in with no advance registration. Bring your supplies and join us to draw or paint (no acrylics or oils) our live models. We don't supply easels, but you may bring your own. All skill levels welcome.

Gesture Sessions (two hours) Loosen up and participate in a fun, fast-paced drawing experience of dynamic 1-5 minute poses. We may throw in a continuous motion drawing exercise to keep things interesting.

Short Pose Sessions (two hours) Sessions feature 5-15 minute poses. Get in lots of drawing practice with a wide variety of poses.

Short/Long Pose Sessions

(three hours) These sessions start with some short 1-5 minute warm-up poses and progressively move into 10-45 minute poses. Hone your drawing and observation skills.

Long Pose Sessions (three hours) These sessions are composed of two long poses starting with a few warm-ups.

From the President ... Our Goals for 2013 and Beyond ...

Happy New Year, DRA members! Your Board of Directors is looking forward to a busy year, with an exciting exhibition schedule, and new projects to inspire your artistic achievements. With five new directors joining us, there should be some interesting things happening, and you'll want to be a part of it!

It's a good time to tell you about our goals for 2013 and beyond. We recently completed our 2013-2014 grant proposal to the Alexandria Commission for the Arts, in which we described what we would be working toward in the coming years:

I. Expand DRA's artistic contributions to the community, by:

- * Increasing the number of educational workshops and classes for local artists;
- * Developing art programs of interest to diverse cultural groups in Del Ray;
- * Continuing our development of art programs and activities for local children;
- * Continuing/expanding collaborations with other arts groups and community venues.

2. Increase fundraising efforts to support and expand our programs, through:

- * Developing and implementing annual fundraising goals;
- * Increasing the number of fundraising events and programs throughout the year;
- * Designating certain funds from other income-producing programs to support stated goals for the year; and
- * Forming a budget and fundraising committee for grants preparation and identifying other available grants.

3. Strengthen our governance and organizational practices, by:

- * Updating our 2007 Strategic Plan;
- * Reviewing and updating our Bylaws, Policies and Board Handbook;
- * Reviewing and updating our performance review process and contracts for our employees, paid consultants and independent contractors;
- * Developing our online membership database and volunteer tracking system; and
- * Regular review and updating of our budget and financial reporting procedures.

We can do this only with the participation of our talented, artistic, loyal membership. Help our hard-working Board of Directors keep DRA a vibrant visual arts center in Del Ray. Volunteer to work with us on one of these projects! — by Michele Reday Cook


- Receiving takes places Sunday, January 27 and Monday, January 28, 2013, from 6–8 pm
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork for display. Non-refundable entry fee is \$5 per piece for Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members, \$8 per piece for non-members. Each artist is also invited to submit three pieces of take-away art for an additional flat entry fee of \$5.
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/ArtGuidelines for details.
- When your art sells, you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax-deductible) to Del Ray Artisans.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, as well as delivery of sold work.
- All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions, and/or take down. Please bring your calendar so you can sign up for duties at receiving. We'll ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception. (DRA Members: The volunteer hours are for entry into this show only and not part of your membership requirement of 10 hours of volunteer time per year to support Del Ray Artisans.)
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for DRA publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist
 as a requisite for entering the show.
- After the entries are accepted for the show, artists may not pick up unsold artwork until the show closes on Sunday, February 24.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
