

It was exciting to see my vision come to life in the gallery. Artworks submitted surpassed any notions I had. Del Ray Artisans has assembled an invaluable curator manual covering the process from concept to clean-up. You'll also need a reliable, responsible support team that understands your vision which will adjust to circumstances along the way. The best way to attract and find this support team is to VOLUNTEER with shows! It's educational and is a great bonding experience with other "creatives".

#### ...and How Not to be "That Artist"

Every curator encounters "That Artist" who asks to turn their work in late, making volunteers re-hang entire walls. "That Artist" does not know the schedule and never signs up to gallery host or help with show duties. "That Artist" does not realize that volunteers who work full-time must hang a show in a few days. "That Artist" might consider helping with hanging and lighting a show; postcard distribution; wall prep, banner hanging, or reception clean-up tasks that are NOT part of required member volunteer hours. "That Artist" hasn't carefully read the Call for Entry, nor respected the show theme, which puts the curator in an awkward position. "That Artist" does not know s/he will NOT get entry fees back. "That Artist" should understand that show themes keep the gallery uniquely "fresh" for our patrons and help artists try new art approaches. "That Artist" should know that Del Ray Artisans is the first gallery in which many of us show our work. Abiding by the carefully thought-out policies keep us in company with other professional art galleries. So don't be "that artist"! Instead, be "The Artist"!!! — Theresa Kulstad

#### **Artwork Left at the Gallery**

As of Jan. 1, all unpurchased artwork must be picked up from the gallery within 30 days after a show closes. ALL artwork left at the gallery after the 30-day deadline WILL become property of Del Ray Artisans.

#### Memoirs of a Show Curator Recapping Reincarnations!

Even on the heels of the Polar Vortex, Del Ray Artisans Gallery was hot, hot, hot on opening night! Artists rose to the occasion in transforming discarded and salvaged items into provocative, interesting artworks.

I was delighted to receive over 100 pieces, many from the "Artcyclopedia" challenge. Juror Rosemary Luckett awarded artworks that showed true transformations and/or developed techniques with definitive designs. Suzanne Tillman received Best in Show for her three collages, a body of work reflecting design sophistication and transformative use of materials. Jen Athanas received Juror's Choice for Best Artsyclopedia for transforming her encyclopedia into a Kimono inspired by the Japanese Tsunami and two influential books. Jen also received Juror's Honorable Mention for her Wedding Garment

created from vintage finds including undergarments. The juror created the Wonderful Whimsy Award for Diane Gamerman and Debbie Mezzetta for their charming artworks displaying professional execution. I chose many Curator's Choices and for Best Artcyclopedia, Curator's Choice: Kathy Turner wowed with a 3-piece ensemble plus brooch created from her encyclopedia. Honorable Mentions and Curator's Choices (chosen by both juror and curator) went to D.J. Gaskin, Lesley Hall, Rusty Lynn, Ann Krug, Stacy Rausch, Ken Reed, Constance Springer, and Jackie Tury. Congratulations to you all!

A wonderful aspect of Reincarnations was that it "resurrected" some folks whose artworks hadn't been seen in the gallery for a while — and some of them were award-winners! The show drew in a few new artists and patrons. One, a retired art critic from The Washington Post, came in during our Valentine card-making event. She was impressed with the show and activity. Reading the newsletter and checking out upcoming shows, she said the artwork was great and the show themes were key in keeping the gallery fresh and unique. She exclaimed "This place is a treasure and a great hub for the community!" — Theresa Kulstad

#### **Entry Details:**

- This show is open to Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members only. (membership must be current)
- Receiving takes place Sunday, March 30 from 6pm-8pm and Monday, March 31 from 6pm-8pm.
- Acceptance of all submissions is at the curators' discretion.
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. For more information, visit: www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html
- Artists may submit up to 2 pieces of artwork for the show at a non-refundable entry fee of \$5 per piece.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork for Art To Go at a non-refundable entry fee of \$2 per piece.
- Artwork for Art To Go must be shrink-wrapped and ready for sale (*framed artwork is not accepted*).
- Diptychs or triptychs that are framed as 2 or 3 separate framed pieces will count as 2 or 3 separate entries; only if the diptych or triptych is framed as one piece will it be accepted as a single entry.

#### **Accepted Artist Requirements:**

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements.
- All artists MUST gallery host and volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. You are also asked to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- When your art sells you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax-deductible) to *Del Ray Artisans*.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist.
- Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for DRA publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Artist must pick up unsold artwork on Sunday, April 27 between 6-8pm unless other arrangements are made with the curators in advance. All unsold artwork left at the gallery for 30 days after the show closes will become the property of Del Ray Artisans.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
- Print out and keep a copy of both sides of this call for entry/entry form for your records.
