Hand Tool Basics offers Tips for Working with Tools

Some artists who incorporate found items in mixed media pieces are discovering that they need to know how to wield hammers and hand files in addition to paint brushes.

On Tuesday, Sept. 23, members of Del Ray Artisans will have the chance to ask Ron Blank, a master conservator, wood worker and long-time DRA member, questions about the right tool to use when using metal, wood and other materials. Ron will demonstrate how to work with different tools. The session will start at 7:30 pm and be held in the gallery. The session is open only to DRA members. Metamorphosis implies a distinct transformative change from one form to another; the key word is change, which can be positive, negative, frightening, enlightening metaphorical or physical. Turn the word upside down. Tear it open. Free yourself.

This juried exhibit is open to all area artists. Elizabeth Ann Coleman, retired director and curator emeritus of textiles and fashion at the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, will serve as the juror.

Art will be accepted 6-8 pm on Sunday,

Sept. 28, and Monday, Sept. 29. An artist may submit up to three entries. The per piece entry fee for members of Del Ray Artisans is \$5 each. Non-members will pay \$8 for each piece entered.



Del Ray Artisans' Cookbook Fundraiser

Call for Cookbook Recipes and Artwork | Due September 26, 2014

Inspired by the upcoming exhibit "Nourish and Flourish: The Food Show" (November 2014), Del Ray Artisans (DRA) is preparing a cookbook to sell during the holiday season and thereafter. Help raise funds for DRA by sending us your recipes for that hearty soup, the cocktail that inspires you to paint, your mother-in-law's signature hors d'oeuvres—which you've improved—or the pie you brought to the DRA member meeting. Recipes are being sought for these categories: Beverages; Appetizers and Snacks; Sauces, Soups, and Stews; Side Dishes; and Desserts. We are also soliciting digital images of members' artwork to put on the cookbook's divider pages (this is **not** limited to work submitted to the November food show).

Recipe and Artwork Entries

- All entries must be emailed no later than Friday, September 26, at 11pm. Send digital submissions to Cookbook@TheDelRayArtisans.org.
- There is no entry fee for submitting recipes or artwork for the cookbook.
- Accepted artwork and recipes will appear in a cookbook offered for sale as a fundraiser for Del Ray Artisans. From these sales, 100 percent of the profits will go to Del Ray Artisans, a 501(3)(c) nonprofit organization.
- You may submit recipe(s) or artwork, or both types of entries, as you wish.
- You must fill in the appropriate fields in the entry form for each entry you submit.

Recipe Entry Details:

- Each person may submit up to five (5) recipes.
- Each recipe must be in an electronic format that can copied and pasted into a document (e.g., text in an email message or a Word or WordPerfect document attached to an email message). We cannot accept scans or photos of handwritten recipes.
- For each recipe, note the following: Recipe Title, List of Ingredients, Directions, and Serving Size/Number of Servings. Also note your name as it should appear in the cookbook and which category the recipe belongs to: Beverages; Appetizers and Snacks; Sauces, Soups, and Stews; Entrees; Side Dishes; or Desserts.
- Your recipe(s) may or may not be included in the cookbook based on the coordinators' selection of recipes for balance in the collection.

Artwork Entry Details:

- Each person may submit up to two (2) pieces of digitally reproduced artwork attached to an email message. The artwork does **not** have to be the same work submitted to the "Nourish and Flourish" show in November.
- The cookbook will use artwork on the "divider pages" marking the cookbook sections. The coordinators will accept only digital images that can be reproduced for this purpose; no physical pieces of art are required.
- Digital artwork should be of a high enough quality to print well on a page approximately 8.5" tall by 5.5" wide.
- Your artwork may or may not be included in the cookbook based on the coordinators' selection of artwork for the divider pages. If your artwork is selected, it may be cropped to fit the space available in the cookbook.


Accepted Artist Requirements:



Metamorphosis

October 3 - November 2, 2014

Metamorphosis implies a distinct transformative change from one form to another. Change can be positive, negative, frightening, or enlightening. Consider physical changes such as a caterpillar's metamorphosis into a butterfly; philosophical changes such as a Christian embracing Buddhism or a liberal switching over to the conservative party; or personal life changes such as marriage, divorce, addiction and rehabilitation.

If such deep thoughts don't stir an idea then perhaps dig out an old painting that never worked out, and rework it in a completely new direction. Turn it upside down. Tear open the canvas (if it's a painting). Free yourself to embrace change for better or for worse.

Art Receiving is Sunday, Sept. 28 and Monday, Sept. 29 from 6-8pm. Artists may submit up to 3 entries, entry fee is \$5 each for members, \$8 each for non-members. This is a juried show is open to all area artists, all media. Since this is a juried open call show there is no guarantee of acceptance for entries. Entry fees are non-refundable.

About our juror: Elizabeth Ann Coleman retired in 2004 as Department Head and Curator of Textiles and Fashion Arts at the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston with the distinction of curator emeritus. Prior to Boston she worked in similar positions with other first tier American museums. Widely published, she has worked on influential historic designers and with notable living fashion and textile designers such as Miyake, Aläia, etc. as well as teaching and critiquing upcoming generations. At the close of her career she was instrumental in bringing the acclaimed Daphne Farago fiber arts collection to Boston where she had additionally overseen one of the museum's most popular exhibitions: Tiaras. Coleman continues to lecture, consult, and write in her field on an international level.

- Artists will be contacted by email on Tuesday, Sept. 30 or Wednesday, Oct. 1 to pick up work that was not accepted on Thursday, Oct. 2 between noon and 6pm.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges
 finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.thedelrayartisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for details.
- All artwork should be available for purchase. When your art sells, you are asked to make a (tax-deductible) 20% donation to Del Ray Artisans
- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, as well as delivery of sold work.
- All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. We'll ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a Del Ray Artisans show.
