


### **Need Co-curator**

### Popular Exhibit at Animal Shelter Leads to November Show

All Creatures Great and Small is generating rave reviews from organizers and the general public during its run at the Viola Lawson Animal Shelter. The show opened Aug. 7 and closes Sunday, Oct. 26.

Sixty pieces ranging from photography to collage to stained glass reflect just how much Del Ray Artisans members love animals with their subjects ranging from cats and dogs to elephants and tigers. Eight pieces sold at the opening reception with a portion from each sale going to the animal league. DRA thanks Chadwicks, King Street Blues, Lavender Moon Cupcakery, Tres Hermanas and Unwined for donating food and beverages for the reception.

If you go to view the show, keep in mind that DRA and the animal shelter are collecting blankets and towels for the animals.

- Open to Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members only
- Artists must upload and send digital submissions to GWW@TheDelRayArtisans.org
- **DEADLINE** is Wednesday, October 15, 2014 (Notification of acceptance by October 20)
- Accepted artwork must be dropped off at the Vola Lawson Animal Shelter (4101 Eisenhower Ave Alexandria VA 22304) on Sunday, October 26 between 3pm and 5pm
- Artists may submit up to three (3) pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for accepted artwork.
- Artists must pay their entry fees when dropping off their accepted artwork at the shelter, or prior to drop-off at Del Ray Artisans. Cash and checks accepted at drop-off; credit card payments must be made at in advance at Del Ray Artisans gallery or at: squareup.com/market/del-ray-artisans/awla
- Final acceptance for this exhibit is at curators' discretion upon viewing artwork at drop-off.
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes; framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. - When your art sells, you are asked to make a 40% donation (tax-deductible) which is evenly split between DRA and AWLA.
