


Coming Soon! GUAC 2016!

You, Too, Can Be a Curator!

Curating is a rewarding job, and this is your chance to be one. Requests for proposals to curate a show are due to Kathy Turner by **June 1, 2016** for shows in 2017. Watch this newsletter for further information. "Curators get to set the vision for the show and framework for artistic inspiration," advises Kathy, Curating Director of DRA.

The curator works on a 12-18 month timeframe. The success of the show depends on the curator. "Successful means several things—fun, popular, well attended, high number of submissions, and good cash flow from sales, workshops, and fundraisers. Every show is expected to more than cover its costs, to contribute to DRA's overhead costs and support special purchases, too.", Kathy says. Assistants help with the myriad of tasks required to put on a show.

Fortunately for the rest of us, DRA has a Curator's Manual to aid you and Kathy Turner as support for guidance. The best thing you could do is to volunteer with a current curator to be an assistant so that you understand the process. Betsy Mead who curated the show *True Colors: Like a Rainbow* on exhibit last month says, "Curating, when it's all done and the curator sees and hears patrons' positive reactions and comments to the artwork, is so fulfilling! Perfect!"

Gallery Without Walls: Two New Shows

DRA Gallery Without Walls curators launched two new shows which both run January 31 through May 15, 2016.

Partnerships at VCA Alexandria Animal Hospital: This is the second collaboration with VCA Alexandria Animal Hospital. When artwork sells, artists are making a 20% donation split evenly between Del Ray Artisans and VCA Alexandria Animal Hospital's charity of choice: Veteran's Moving Forward. Around the Next Corner at the Vola Lawson Animal Shelter: This is the fifth collaboration with the Animal Welfare League of Alexandria (AWLA). In this fundraising exhibit, artists are making a 40% donation split evenly between AWLA and DRA when artwork sells. View the exhibit weekdays from 12-7pm (closed Wednesday) and weekends 12-5pm at the animal shelter located at 4101 Eisenhower Ave, Alexandria, VA 22304.
