Fire and Earth: National Ceramic Cup Exhibit and Regional 2-D Show (September 2-October 2, 2016)

The call for entry is open for this hybrid event that combines a national ceramic cup exhibit and a regional 2-D show. Fire and earth are two of the four elements. This exhibit honors how fire in the kiln (be it fueled by wood, gas, or electricity) transforms earth (clay) into functional drinking vessels (cups, mugs, tankards, tumblers, goblets, and teabowls). The 2-D exhibit on the walls of the gallery should reflect and communicate about these elements and with the 3-D ceramic pieces. The 2-D work's theme of illustrating the forces of nature allows a broad interpretation of how the natural elements affect our world, and echoes the process of the ceramic art. The exhibit is juried by Dan Finnegan, a nationally and internationally recognized potter. There will be cash prizes both for the cups (including the "St. Elmo's Cup"), and the 2-D work. For artists juried into the 2-D show they can also submit work for the Marketplace (Marketplace art work does not have to reflect the show's theme and is cash-and- carry). There are separate CFEs for the 3-D and 2-D entries (with different entry dates) as well as information about a workshop from the juror that will be hosted by the Clay Queen in Del Ray.

Entry to this exhibit is by online submission. The 3-D Ceramic Cup entries are due by midnight on Saturday, July 30. The 2-D Exhibit entries are due by midnight on Saturday, August 13. Details and entry forms at TheDelRayArtisans.org/CFE

Congratulations to Isaiah Wilkerson, 2016 Winner of the Ted Eichers Memorial Art Scholarship

Isaiah will put his scholarship money to good use as he plans to attend Northern Virginia Community College and study animation. Since 2000, Del Ray Artisans has awarded the Ted Eichers Memorial Art Scholarship to a T.C. Williams High School graduate who is attending college to continue his or her art education. The \$1000 scholarship is awarded to recipients selected by a committee appointed by The Scholarship Fund of Alexandria and based on criteria set by DRA. The student must have a B average, show extraordinary potential in art and be planning to major in an art-related field.

Paint Del Ray a Success

On June 2, 2016, DRA hosted the First Thursday "Paint Del Ray" event, a first of its kind bringing artists and the public together for a night of art demonstrations and community art activities. Along Mount Vernon Avenue 12 artists set up their easels on the sidewalk near participating businesses and demonstrated their work for the public to view and admire. DRA artists Kajal Dhabalia and Jenny Nicholson painted storefront windows at St. Elmo's and The Dairy Godmother and Josh Oliveira completed a large mural that hung on the exterior wall of Stomping Grounds. Community art activities included rock painting at Greenstreet Gardens, painting an old van at Alexandria Hyundai, creating a recycled bottle mural near Top it Off, designing a DASH bus advertising card, and painting Photo Op board designs sketched by Dawn Wyse Hurto and Corrin Pumphrey.

Mount Vernon Recreation Center students participated with their Birds of a Feather project involving placement of painted feathers on a bird they designed. The UNITY project was launched in Kisskadee's grassy area-participants wrapped colorful yarn around posts to reflect their identities. Their yarns intertwined on 32 posts to create a web of interconnectedness showing that we are all connected by something, and it emphasized the diversity that builds a strong and vibrant community. This night made all participants feel like the community had unity through art.
