only accepting the limits of an endless sky have been a theme for many artists and reflect a very current theme.



The Opening Reception is our way of celebrating our artists, and sharing their art with the world (we hope!). If you've attended DRA for any of our events, you already know that we treat our guests well! We appreciate that you have taken the time to come and share in the vision of our artists.
