Del Ray Artisans and Union 206 Studio are seeking fine art photography that showcases artists' visions of beauty. Fine art photography is about how the artist communicates their vision, whether an idea, a message, or an emotion. This may be something small, like a single word such as symmetry, or it may be a whole state-

ment, like exploring the way the light falls over the nude form. The camera is merely a tool to make an art piece that reveals the artist's vision and produces a more personal – typically more evocative or atmospheric, yet aesthetic – statement. Art pieces will demonstrate careful staging, composition and lighting of the subject, as well thoughtful post-processing techniques (if desired) and selection of production material to make an individual expression. The Amazing Technicolor OffBeat Auction

Del Ray Artisans found a formula in our early years for some truly successful "FUN"draising. The OffBeat Auction kept DRA alive and growing, as we created remarkable art and strong bonds among our members. The formula involved six months of workshops to teach our members new techniques to transform discarded furniture into functional art pieces. We then auctioned these pieces to the public in a gala event.

Since the classes were taught in the gallery, we could only host exhibits for half of that year – but the amount of funds which were raised were enough to budget over two years, so we adopted a pattern of holding the OffBeat Auction every other year.

Furniture pieces were donated or found on the curb, and repaired as necessary, often by long-time member Ron Blank, a wood/furniture conservator. There were workshops in faux finishing, mosaics, tile making, and many other decorative techniques. Our creations were one-of-a-kind masterpieces.

Next month we'll share how those OffBeat pieces were brought to the public.

Del Ray Artisans continues its 25th Anniversary celebrations this year with a special auction event called *Twisted Masterpieces* at Port City Brewing Company. There will be a live auction of found & rejuvenated furniture by invited artists and a silent auction of donated art pieces. All donating artists will be acknowledged in the program, and a donation receipt will be given to those artists.

This Call for Donations requests donated **2-dimensional** and **3-dimensional works of art** for the silent auction. There will only be 50 slots for donated artwork due to limited time and space. You may donate only one piece—a new or an old piece. All donated artwork is much appreciated. The proceeds from the silent auction benefit Del Ray Artisans to preserve its current activities and continue to promote art in the community.

Entry Details:

- NO ENTRY FEE. Open to members and non-members.
- Entry to this auction is by online submission.
- One submission per artist. Art may be in any medium.
- 2-D artwork size limit is 16" X 20" including frame and 3-D size limit is 12" X 12" X 12".
- Artwork must have a value of \$100 or more. All donated pieces will start off with a bid of \$25.
- Art should be ready to hang with wire and screw eyes, mounting, framed, or with edges finished.
- All art entered must be original. Work previously shown at Del Ray Artisans gallery is eligible.
- Final acceptance for the exhibit will be at the curator's discretion upon physically viewing accepted artwork at Artwork Receiving.
- Each artist is asked to donate the accepted submitted piece of artwork to benefit Del Ray Artisans.

- Deadline for **Digital Submission: Monday, August 14, 2017** by midnight.
- Artists will be notified of artwork acceptance by Friday, August 19.
- Artwork receiving for accepted donated artwork will be on Sunday, August 27 and Monday, August 28 from 6-8pm at Del Ray Artisans (2704 Mount Vernon Avenue, Alexandria, VA 22301).
- The Auction is on **Thursday, September 28, 2017 from 7-9pm at Port City Brewing Company** (3950 Wheeler Avenue, Alexandria, VA 22304). Tickets for the auction are \$25 each and must be purchased in advance.
