Once again the Holiday Market will be 3 consecutive weekends, offering booth space as well as wall space to artists, and featuring different artists each weekend. Each weekend, there will be room for approximately 10 tabletop "booth" exhibitors and from 4 to 8 wall exhibitors (2D work only). Both booth spaces and wall spaces are \$60/weekend for Del Ray Artisans members and \$85/weekend for non-members. Half-wall spaces are also available (\$40/\$55). See application for more details on the space options.

Artists must pay the space fee with their application; however, artists not selected will be refunded the space fee. Cancellations and no-shows will NOT be refunded.

Accepted artists are also asked to donate 10% of their total sales (tax-deductible donation) to Del Ray Artisans at the conclusion of their weekend.

Each weekend will still be designed as a "balanced market" (we cannot have all photographers or all jewelers, etc), so not all accepted artists are guaranteed their first choice weekend.

All work sold at the Holiday Market must be handmade <u>by the artist selling</u> the work and originals need to have been made within the last 3 years. Reproductions are acceptable as long as the original was made by the artist within the last 3 years.

Del Ray Artisans reserves the right to remove any item(s) from sale, at any time, for any reason. The artist may only sell artwork in the media category that was indicated on the artist's application.
