ARTISANS' CENTER TO STAY AT 2210 MT. VERNON AVE FOR INTERIM

The ARF Executive Board is relieved to report that we have a home through the end of September. Rodger Digilio, developer and owner of Potomac Town Square, has accepted the board's offer to stay in our current digs through the end of September, at a slightly higher rent than we now pay (but still well below market rent). By some time in August, we should know whether the center can stay put through the end of the year.

However, the search is still on for a new, permanent home. The prospect of a larger facility presents a number of exciting opportunities for us. In addition to larger exhibition space, ARTS RESOURCE FOUNDATION hopes to also provide dedicated instructional space for classes. demonstations, and workshops, and is exploring the possibility of providing limited studio space. ARF has developed a Request for Proposals seeking 2,500 10,000 square feet retail/warehouse space along Mount Vernon Avenue or an adjacent retail corridor.
