#### 1995 BRINGS CHANGE

The Well-Crafted Word brings news of big changes here at Del Ray Artisans Center. As most of you have probably noticed, our gallery space at 2210 Mt. Vernon Avenue has been vacated so that a market-rate tenant can occupy the space. As part of the agreement, the tenant, Alexandria Volunteer Bureau, will provide us with needed space to conduct business-related matters and to maintain the current mailing address and telephone number for the Del Ray Artisans' Center.

At a recent meeting of the Executive Board our visionary Executive Director. Smirniotopoulos tendered his resignation. It was accepted with great reluctance. Peter and his Lauren founded Del Ray Artisans' Cooperative along with Nick Bayus, Terry Atkin, Rob Reuter and Steve and Ann Campbell just three years ago. Since then none of our lives has been the same. The amount of commitment and energy required to drive such an enterprise has been formidable. We offer our gratitude to Peter and wish him well in his new job. His exhuberance and commitment will be greatly missed.

Since Peter's resignation the duties and responsibilities of his position are being shared jointly by a group of members serving as the Acting Board. Without the overhead associated with dedicated gallery space, the Acting Board has begun exploring a new idea for on-going exhibitions. The new concept will focus exhibtion schedules around the concept of being a Gallery-Without-Walls which will utilize existing vacant spaces. In fact, this idea has had two successful try-outs coordinated with Alexandria real estate firms, McEnearney Associates and Long and Foster - Old Town.

Over the weekend of December 17th and 18th the works of fifteen artists were on display. The participants offered a wide range of arts and crafts including; jewelry, stained glass, paintings, photography, etchings, boxes, handmade books and Christmas ornaments.

Helen reports that we had a very good crowd, "at least 200 people on Saturday and nearly that many on Sunday," The show raised \$ 660.00 through entry fees and donations from sales by the artisans. We sold the remainder of the Del Ray Is A State of Mind tee shirts and best of all we had fun.
