The DEL RAY ARTISANS are proud to present The Mud Women Ceramics by Jane Cullum, Fran Newquist and Helen Ottaway. The exhibit will grace Del Ray Artisans Center October 6th - 9th. An Opening Reception is set for Friday, October 6th from 6 - 9 PM at the Center, 2003B Mt. Vernon Avenue.

We are pleased to be hosting a collaboration by such an accomplished group of "mud women."

Jane Cullum is known for her functional ceramics, primarily in stonewear. She teaches in her studio in McLean and at Pine Ridge Pottery in Alexandria.

Fran Newquist's studio and show room are located at the Tin Barn in The Plains, Virginia. She works mostly in stoneware and raku and makes functional pieces and decorative work.

Helen Ottaway will show porcelain with chrystalline glazes and raku. Some of Helen's large pastels and watercolors will also be included in this show. The work will range in price from inexpensive functional pieces, such as mugs and bowls to larger, more complex pieces. Don't miss this special show Friday through Monday October 6th - 9th.

REGISTER NOW FOR FALL CLASSES AT DEL RAY ARTISANS CENTER!

DECORATIVE FINISHES I
Students must bring a bucket, plastic gloves and wear old clothes.
This is an introduction to faux finishing/decorative finishes. Students will come away with 4-5 finished samples of their work learned in class. We will open with a description of the paints used, how to mix a glaze, what base coats to prepare, tools to use, and how to avoid mistakes in accomplishing a wonderful painted finish. Students will complete sample boards using these techniques: sponging, dragging (simple antique wood grain), verdigris, stippling and a couple simple marbles.
DECORATIVE FINISHES II
Again, students will come away from class with 4-5 finished sample boards. We will create: granite, green marble, fantasy marble, carrera marble and yellow marble. We will varnish our boards and students will receive detailed instruction on the procedure for preparing and finishing many kinds of surfaces to take a painted finish like the ones we are creating in class.
About the Instructor: Sarah Pearson has a BA in Interior Design from Marymount University. She has taught Faux Finishing and Decorative Finishes classes for the Del Ray Artisans Center, Springfield Art Guild and Fairfax County's Adult Education program. Sarah was given a one-woman show at Del Ray Artisans Center in May '93 for her functional art (painted furniture). She has also shown in galleries and boutiques in McLean and Alexandria, Virginia and Potomac, Maryland. She has recently branched out to faux finishing columns, doors and small walls for interior designers and clients in the Metropolitan area.
