DEL RAY ARTISANS ISO TALENT

There are many ways you can support our efforts to build a strong community arts center. At the February membership meeting these openings were identified:

Artisan Historian: Create a timeline that documents the founding, art exhibitions, awards, moves, partnerships and progress of the Del Ray Artisans.

Membership Chairperson and Committee Members: Assemble and distribute new member welcome kits. Follow up on guest book names to send them membership information. Maintain and update member data base so that information on areas of expertise can be tapped and networking can be done better.

Gallery Without Walls Coordinator: Make contacts with sites that have stated a willingness to show Artisan artwork and create a schedule of rotating artists to exhibit. Expand the number of sites so that these satellite galleries create "perpetual" exhibit opportunities for our members.

Graphic Design Committee Members: Contribute design and layout ideas for Artisan postcards, flyers and other publicity. Coordinate with exhibition curators to meet mailing deadlines. THANK YOU TO: Jane DeWeerd and Kate Grumbacher for volunteering to serve on the Membership Committee, O. Dasent for offering to design a web site for the Del Ray Artisans and Linda Silk for signing on as Gallery Coordinator.
