Treasurer: Keeps the books for Del Ray Artisans. Pays bills and reimburses members for expenses. Keeps an inventory of fundraising items. Files documents with IRS and articles of incorporation. Provides financial data for grants. Contact person: Marlin Lord at 683-1112

Secretary: Takes notes at meetings. Writes letters on behalf of the Del Ray Artisans Board. Contact person: Mart Larson 836-0413
