The gallery will be open weekends from 9am-5pm for final furniture touch-up and polyurethaneing Oct. 30-31, Nov. 6-7 and Nov. 13. Please come and help your fellow artists! We'll train you to apply poly! If you can drag a brush across a piece of paper, then you can apply poly. Contact David Talmage (703-768-0709 or talmage@ricochet.net).

If you adopted furniture, please return your completed work(s) of art to the gallery no later than Sun., Nov. 7. "Completed" means that the work has enough coats of varnish or polyurethane to protect it during normal use. Any artist who returns unprotected furniture after November 7 will be handed a sponge brush and a cup of liquid poly on the spot.

Please include a description of the piece(s) with the following information for the auction catalog and for the auctioneer's reference: Name of Artist, Title, Description, Special care instructions: (e.g.) not dishwasher safe; indoor use only.

ALL work on furniture must be completed by the end of the day on Sat., Nov. 13 because Sun., Nov. 14 is clean up (and boy, does the gallery need it!) and set up for the Preview Exhibit. Contact Kathryn Brown (549-5227 or neonkanb@aol.com) to help with this big clean-up/set-up job.


