

Grant Proposal-Alexandria Commission for the Arts

The Del Ray Artisans submitted the Operational Grant proposal to the Alexandria Commission for the Arts in November. We were able to apply for an amount equal to 20% of our 2001-2002 expenses, roughly equaling \$6,500.00. Grant review takes two paths, accepted or not accepted. The proposals that are accepted then are further qualified to receive either full or partial funding by the Commission. The Commission recommendations are forwarded to the

City Council for a vote. At any point in this process the amount requested may be reduced.
