Alexandria Commission for the Arts Interview

On Saturday, January 11th, **Susan Slattery, Jen Chappell** and **Dave Nicholson** went before the Alexandria
Commission for the Arts to be
interviewed concerning the DRA Grant
Application for FY 2003-04. This
represented the 2nd step in obtaining a
Grant from the City of Alexandria.

Very favorable comments were made by various Commission members regarding the outreach and impact that DRA has and continues to have in Alexandria. There were questions about funding arrangements, diversity, commission structure and long-term site plans. Each question was addressed and the Commission members seemed satisfied with the responses.

We now must wait to hear whether the Commission recommended us for full or partial funding. Then the City will decide on the actual, if any, Grant we might receive. A final decision will not be received until April or May, 2003.
