# **Art/Book Fair is Coming**

DRA's first Art/Book Fair will take place Saturday, April 19th, from 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM in the outdoor ball field area of Mt. Vernon Elementary School. The field is located between the Mt. Vernon Recreation Center (2701 Commonwealth Avenue) and the Del Ray Artisans' gallery space.

This free event will feature multiple art forms including visual arts workshops for children and storytellers along with dramatic, musical and dance performances. Food will be available for purchase and there will be a free drawing for gift baskets of books, CDs and other items. Coupons will be distributed for free books, and more. DRA and Trilogy Group (Mt. Vernon Recreation Center, the Duncan Library, and the Mt. Vernon Elementary School) have come together to address the growing gap between the primarily English-speaking community of Del Ray and our Hispanic neighbors in Arlandria by inviting children and their parents to attend a day particularly designed with them in mind. Reading

and literacy are the focus, and the unique USBORN series of books, written in Spanish, will be for sale at the fair. DRA is promoting the performing arts in conjunction with various "hands on", interactive activities planned for children. With Art/Book, we hope to foster a sense of inclusion and bonding in the artistically rich Del Ray community.

Offering a festive atmosphere and a lively, inviting display of art, music, and dance programs throughout the day, the Art/Book Fair is open to children throughout the community. Local artists, musicians, dancers and television producers will present their particular art forms. Following each performance or demonstration, the artists will conduct a question and answer session with the audience. This marks the sixth year that the Del Ray Artisans have sponsored this exhibition that showcases art work by students enrolled in four Alexandria City public schools. Curator, Linda Silk, who founded the exhibition in 1998, coordinates with the art faculty of Minnie Howard School, F.C. Hammond Middle School, George Washington Middle School and T.C. Williams High School to bring their students art work out of the classroom and into public view.

Nurturing new and developing talent is an intrinsic part of Del Ray Artisans' mission. Our continued support of this project, and Linda's dedication to the artists of the future, has helped this show grow to the size that it now exhibits the output of nearly 200 young artists from grades 6 through 12. Each year the art work is exuberant, edgy and enlightening. It also offers an interesting glimpse into the psyche of today's youth.

The opening reception for the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Student Art Show will be held on May 7<sup>th</sup> from 7:00-9:30PM. During the reception, the Del Ray Artisans will announce this year's winner of the Ted Eichers Memorial Art Scholarship.
