

The award is for the "good work in designing and maintaining the landscaping at the Nicholas Colasanto Center is such a way that it is a pleasure for the passer-by and an asset to the City." Criteria for making the award included visibility from the public right of way: plant colors; textures and forms; maintenance; proportion; landscaping accents and elements; and relationship to the neighborhood.
