The return of the Wood Show



From the modern design aesthetic of furniture maker Hugh Belton to the signature fluted trumpet bell forms of Phil Brown, "Washington Wood 2005" and the concurrent Del Ray Artisans' "Still Life, Landscape and Other Perspectives" exhibit, will present a juried selection of work in the gallery. Curator **Martin Angebranndt** promises it will be another exciting collaboration of the two groups.

Among the twenty Woodworkers Guild members exhibiting will be **Patrick O'Brien**, who specializes in natural edge turnings; John Noffsinger, a turner who specializes in post turning treatments including pyrography and dyed woods, and **Alan Becker**, who was recently featured in "Élan" design magazine.

Curator Angebranndt, also an accomplished woodworker, will be exhibiting his piece "Challenged Perspectives--an homage to William Bailey" in the show. Angebranndt describes the piece as being "made of walnut

and walnut-veneered plywood with the shelf tilting downward at 3.5 degrees. Each turned object on the shelf is turned in two axis to allow them to sit plumb on the tilted surface to surprise the viewer. The arrangement of objects recalls still life paintings with dueling perspectives such those by William Bailey."

Displayed on the walls will be the "Still Life, Landscape and Other Perspectives" exhibit which will feature art by ten DRA members. The exhibit includes work by watercolorist Alice Kale, known for her skilled renderings of Del Ray, along with photography, paintings and more by Barbara Chiminello, Candace Clifford, Michele Reday Cook, Beverly Hilbert, Steve Polo and Diane McClaugherty.

Opening Friday, November 4 (7-10 PM), the concurrent shows will run through Sunday, November 27, 2005. Gallery hours are Saturdays, 10-4PM / Sundays, noon-4PM.

All ornament proceeds will go directly to the artists, who need not be present for the ornament sale.

The Ancient Muses were the Greek goddesses who presided over the arts and sciences, inspiring those who excel at those pursuits. In fact, the word museum is derived from Muses meaning "a place or source of inspiration." In January 2006, the "Name Your Muse" juried show, curated by **Richard Wyvill** and **Karen Schmitz**, will give artists the opportunity to share their Muse(s). The exhibit entry fee (members-\$10 / non-members \$15) will allow artists to submit up to three new works of art, each with its own muse: a person, an

animal, a place or object; a memory, a poem or a song, etc.

Georgia O'Keefe had the stunning American Southwest as her Muse, while Edward Weston's wife Charis was the inspiration (and his model) for a famous series of nude photographs. John Lennon composed "Imagine" as a utopian anthem to his dream of world peace. Let Name Your Muse reveal the inspiration(s) behind your work! Exhibit dates are January 6-29. The exhibit call for entry is enclosed in this newsletter.
