Del Ray Dozen Invitational Photography Show

The Del Ray Artisans all-photography show returns on November 9. The Del Ray Dozen Invitational Photography Show will feature the work of fifteen photographers.

Participating members are: Kathryn Brown, Amy Bruce, Candace Clifford, Jen Chappell, Dee Ellison, Judy Heffner, Paige Ireland, David Kosar, Marlin Lord, LeAnn Pittman, Rob Rudick, Dave Scavone, Fierce Sonia, Lara Tiller and Rita Yurow.

They will be presenting a variety of works with subjects ranging from land-scapes, abstracts and flowers to vintage automobiles. Amy Bruce will present creations from alternative processes such as Emulsion Lifts, to highlight architectural elements in a unique way. Dave Scavone is showing his "Foundling" series of still lifes of found objects. Paige Ireland's use of photographs and mirrors in old window frames will also be displayed. Different approaches to photography will include: digital and macro photographs, along with traditional color and black and white film photography.

The opening reception is Friday, November 9, 2007 from 7-10 p.m. and includes a silent auction of photography pieces created by "the Dozen." The exhibition runs through November 26. Gallery Hours are Saturdays, and Friday, November 23, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. and Sundays, Noon - 4 p.m.

JUST HANG IT at HOME! The Art of Hanging.

- Do not fear the nail hole. Enter a room with fresh eyes and determine which walls have high visual impact. That's prime art hanging real estate. Select an art piece or grouping for that spot. Don't worry you can always change it (and your should periodically).
- 2. Quick tip. Cut the shape(s) of your art work out of newspaper and either position on the wall or assemble on floor. Keeping them close, thinking about positive and negative space as well as color and style. Frames do not have to match. Hang to your eye level for single pieces or the average height for groups.
- **3 Mix those mediums.** Paintings on canvas, drawings under glass, **B&W** photos and 3-D pieces. Or, add an empty frame to your grouping to make an artistic statement.
- **4 Let your personality shine.** Hanging unusual personal items like: artsy purses, vintage shopping bags, clothing articles on hangers, and jewelry. Mix it up with small inexpensive shelves to display ceramic and mixed media pieces.
- 5 Best advice. After you have hung your art in your home, move it! Change it for the season or just because! You will see your works of art with fresh eyes! Enjoy your art and home! And, please put those holes in the wall!

Garden Fan-Flower-Tastic!

Our Gardening Committee put forth a spectacular effort at the Fall clean-up. The DRA Garden is a shining star thanks to their HARD WORK!

In one day they managed to plant Shrub Rose, Creeping Sedum, New York Asteraceae, Pansies, Japanese Dwarf Mondo Grass, Ornamental Millet, Lantana, Perennial Salvia, Ornamental Cabbage, Hyssop Gigantica (Lamiaciae). Landscaping fabric was laid under the mulch, around the entire electric box area and beneath the front of building where flood lighting was placed. Stepping stones were installed for easier access to sign replacement. Pruning, weeding and dead plant removal was performed in all areas. A delightful water feature was added in the front yard with pansies and Mondo Grass. The front door looks fresh and clean with a new coat of plum paint!
