The Spirit of Del Ray - Opens March 7

his year Alexandria celebrates the 100-year anniversary of the founding of the Town of Potomac. In the early 1900's, Del Ray and St Elmo were expanding to house the railroad workers at Potomac Yards. In 1908 the Town of Potomac was incorporated to better serve the needs of these neighborhoods with police and fire services, a mayor, and city council. According to the Office of Historic Alexandria, the City of Alexandria annexed the Town of Potomac in 1930. Although the town ceased to exist, the spirit established between Del Ray and its neighboring communities lives on today. We invite you to take part in the Del Ray Artisans show, "The Spirit of Del Ray," March 7-30, to celebrate the Town of Potomac Centennial. For people who wish to expand their vision and technical abilities in making images. This is the second half of the 9-week "Imaging from Inside Digital Photography Basics" syllabus. Requirement: understanding of white balance, histograms, light temperatures, and digital cas well as exposure basics.
