Another fun activity during the Artioms show is a self-marketing workshop for artists. This workshop is scheduled for 7pm on Friday, February 19. This workshop is all about finding the words to express yourself and your artwork to others. The Tuesdays at Two writers group will guide workshop registrants through some word and writing exercises to loosen up our thoughts about how we describe our art. Space is limited so register early!

### Introduction to Figure Drawing Workshop – Tuesday, February 23rd, 2-5 pm

If you are interested in life drawing but have been apprehensive about coming to our regular open sessions, join us for a special Introduction to Figure Drawing Workshop. Hamil Ma, a resident of Alexandria and instructor at Prince George's Community College and VisArts, has graciously agreed to hold this instructional session at the Del Ray Artisans gallery.

Hamil Ma will cover basic techniques and strategies for getting started with drawing the figure. Demonstrations to facilitate the learning process will be followed by a chance for participants to practice drawing from a live model. Bring paper (18"x24"), pencil, compressed charcoal, kneaded eraser, backing board and portable easel (optional). All levels of drawing skill are welcome.

#### Needed are:

- Teachers should be specifically interested in providing classes in ceramics, photography, origami, music, and dance.
- Teachers get paid a small stipend.

<u>Volunteers</u> to assist in project sessions, lead games, supervise clean-up, play time and meal time.
