"The Gathering of the Legends" Photography Exhibition Opening August 6

Living Legends of Alexandria, 2009-2010, features 30 of Alexandria's recent history makers, many of whom will attend the opening reception on Friday, August 6, 7-10 pm. The Art of Photojournalism, an Artist's Talk, will take place Thursday, August 12, 7-8:30 pm. The show continues through August 22.

Created by artist-photographer Nina Tisara, Living Legends of Alexandria is an ongoing, not-for-profit project to identify, honor and chronicle individuals who have made important contributions to the city's quality of life. The twelve individuals or teams selected as this year's Living Legends are: Chet Avery, Rosalind Bovey, V. Rodger Digilio, Nelson A. Green, Sr., Alice Merrill and Linda Odell, T. Michael Miller, John Porter, Joan and John Renner, David G. Speck, Pat Troy, Lois Walker, and Betty R. Wright.

Past Legends have included educators, artists, arts advocates, clergy, business people, lawyers, and community activists. Legends have created theater companies, computer training programs for low income citizens, a boat building school for at-risk youth, programs to stop child abuse and to improve community health, and much more.

"GLOBAL RHYTHM" ROCKS GALLERY AT JULY 2 OPENING RECEPTION

The opening began with a steady hum of visitors to a boisterous rumble of enthusiastic, purchasing art lovers. The crowd was peppered with familiar faces well as new ones, which included the former Ambassador to Cambodia and future Ambassador to Slovenia. Seduced by the dulcet sounds of foreign music from the sound system to the array of international appetizers to the inspired artwork, the night truly vibrated in a "Global Rhythm".

"Global Rhythm" represented DRA's first national open-call art exhibition. Showcased were twelve local artists and

one artist from New York. Artists were given their own spaces to display all their submitted work as a "mini-collection" inspired by their chosen global locale. Each display exhibited the artist's bio, inspiration, artist statement, and contact information. Artists were invited to use their display to convey their ideas and inspirations and to be at the opening reception to answer visitors' questions.

The show was juried by four accomplished artists: Tania Teschke, international photographer from Moscow; Tony Rienemann, oil painter and digital artist from New York; Gwen McKenzie , ceramist and designer also from New York; and Edrick Ngai, fashion photographer and oil painter from New York and Japan.
