The Del Ray Dozenz Photography Show, November 4 - 27

Be one of the dozens to attend Del Ray Artisans' first all-mem-

ber, all-photography show, the Del Ray Dozenz! Come to the Photographers' Opening Reception Friday, Nov. 4, from 7-10 pm.

The intention of this show is to highlight the work from the ever-growing cadre of Del Ray Artisans photographers. The best images from over three dozen of them will be on display.

Subjects include flora and fauna, interiors and exteriors, world travel, landscapes, and portraits. The pictures are provocative; they're beautiful; they're colorful (except when they're not). Yes, black and white is still alive. Keep an eye out for the prints on aluminum. Look for artists you're familiar with; and those who are new and emerging. December Show: It's all about the little things

This show will run December 9 - 18. Artwork receiving is December 3 and 4, 6:30-8:30 pm. Your artwork may be tiny, diminutive, miniature, but not quite microscopic—we want to be able to see what our artists create!



Some would say it's a small world, a very small world and smaller can be better. The challenge to our artists is to see what they can create in 8"x10" or smaller, in two- or three-dimensional format.

No work will exceed 8 inches by 10 inches in any direction or dimension. Groupings of small works will be shown as a cohesive body of work and will count as only one entry.

Each artist is limited to three (3) entries. The fee is \$5 per entry, or 3 entries for \$12. This is an all-media show for Del Ray Artisans members only. For more information, see the enclosed Call for Entry form.
