
Clay Portrait Workshop Rick Jones, Instructor Sat., April 28 & Sun., April 29, 9 am - Ipm

Eight people minimum and 9 max for workshop. Fee: members \$130; non-members \$140.

This workshop is designed to introduce the participants to a basic study of the human head using an armature and clay. Instructor will provide participants with an armature and one bag of clay. Participants will work with building the portrait structure on day one and use a model on day two. Principle of proportion will be discussed to better capture the physical and artistic expression. Lectures and demos will

be presented throughout the day. The fee includes one bag of clay, the 4-hour model fee and instructor built armature. Firing fees and additional model time is extra. All work must be removed at the end of the workshop.

Entry Details:

Our April show commemorates the Virginia Art Commissions' Minds Wide Open, a celebration of children and the arts.

- This show is open to All Area Artists.
- Receiving takes place Sunday April 1, 6:30-8:30pm and Monday April 2, 6-8pm.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for members, \$8 per piece for non-members. Entry fee for 3-D artwork is \$2 for members per piece, \$8 non-members per piece (max two pieces). Please indicate if these works are Not For Sale (NFS) or priced to sell. (Entry Fee is non-refundable). Submission fees are non-refundable.
- Artists submitting work for display may also submit up to three additional matted & shrink-wrapped pieces for art-to-go sales. Entry fee is \$5 for up to three art-to-go sale items. These works must be no larger than 18"x24" and priced to sell. When art-to-go items sell, the artist (at the curators' discretion) may replenish them. (No additional entry fee.)
- Contact curators if you are planning on submitting 3-D artwork.
- Artists will be notified by email on April 3 if their artwork is not selected.
- Artwork must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. See www.thedelrayartisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for more information.
- When your art sells, you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax deductible) to Del Ray Artisans. To have this automatically deducted from your sale, please check the opt-in box on the submission form.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements, as well as delivery of sold work.
- All artists MUST gallery sit and volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. We'll ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for DRA publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
- Any Artwork left over 30 days will be automatically donated to DRA for silent auction.
