# What Happens After an Artwork Is Sold

You've submitted an art piece to a show, and it was selected — GREAT! Your piece was sold, gasp! — GREAT and congratulations! Now what?...

#### Here's what happens after an artwork is sold:

All sales are processed at the end of the show — no check is cut before the show finishes. Once the show closes, the Office Manager (who works on Thursdays and Fridays):

- 1. Reviews the sales sheet for the show.
- 2. Writes a check for each artist who sold something; if an artist sells more than one item, then the sales are totalled together; if an artist agrees (on the Call for Entry) to have the 20% donation removed, that will be minused from the sales total; this option also provides the artist with the purchaser's name and contact information.
- 3. Mails out that check within 2 weeks of the show closing (maybe sooner).

#### **Entry Details:**

- This show is open to all area artists.
- Receiving takes place Sunday September 30, 6:30-8:30 pm and Monday October 1, 6:30-8:30 pm.
- Artists may submit up to 2 pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for members, \$8 per piece for non-members. Please indicate if these works are Not For Sale (NFS) or priced to sell.
- Artists submitting work for display may also submit up to three additional matted & shrink-wrapped pieces for Take-Away-Art sales. Entry fee is \$5 for up to three Take-Away-Art items. These works must be no larger than 18"x24" and priced to sell. When take-away items sell, the artist (at the curators' discretions) may replenish them at no additional entry fee.
- Limited space for 3-D work due to Special Events please contact Curators.
- Your art must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. We cannot show work that is not ready for exhibition. - Artwork that is still wet (paint, glue or other material) will not be accepted.
- When your art work sells, you are asked to make a 20% donation (tax deductible) to Del Ray Artisans. To have this automatically deducted from your sale, please check the opt-in box on the other side of this form.


#### **Accepted Artist Requirements:**

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements as well as delivery of sold work.
- All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions, and/or take down. Please bring your calendars so you can sign up for duties at receiving. These hours don't count towards your 10 volunteer hours required as a member. We'll also ask you to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Insurance for artwork and all arrangements for work sold is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for DRA publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a DRA show.
- Any artwork left over 30 days after artwork pickup date will be automatically donated to DRA for silent auction.
