"Telling Images" Photography Show Launches November 2

DRA's juried photography exhibit opens Nov. 2 (reception: 7 - 10 pm). The jurors are E. Brady Robinson, photographer-educator with studios in Washington, DC and Florida, and local fine art photographer John H. Brown, Jr. His work is collected worldwide.

Saturday, Nov. 3, 4:00 pm: John H. Brown, Jr. (www.johnbrownphotography.com) and E. Brady Robinson (www.ebradyrobinson.com) will give a gallery talk about "Telling Images" and the selection process. Ms. Robinson is Associate Professor, School of Visual Arts and Design, University of Central Florida and Education Consultant for FotoWeekDC. She writes for Professional Artist Magazine/the Business Magazine for Visual Artists. Her project "Desks as Portraits: An Inside Look at the DC Art World" won Grand Prize in the "American Life" exhibition, 2011 Lishui Photography Festival.

Saturday, Nov. 17: John H. Brown, Jr. will review portfolios of those who have registered for a specific 20-minute time slot that day. The fee is \$35. John's work is featured in collections including the US Department of State's ART in Embassies Program; Marriott Corporation; The Washington Post Company; and Banana Republic/GAP.
