Changes to Del Ray Artisans' Gallery Without Walls Program

Major changes, new venues, and new approaches are on the horizon for the Gallery Without Walls (GWW) program! Tracing back to the early days of DRA, the program has sought opportunities for DRA members to show their art outside our own gallery. Here's a preview of several new exhibit opportunities being planned in the newlyexpanded GWW program!

- The Prudential PenFed offices in Old Town Alexandria, GWW will become a solo and small-group exhibit opportunity. Del Ray Artisans has partnered with Prudential PenFed for the past four years, with selected works from our shows traveling to the realtors' office three or four times a year. Starting in July 2014, we will invite a single artist or a small group (fewer than six) of artists to present proposals for exhibits of up to 30 to 40 2D pieces, which will be on display for four months and include an opening reception.
- Beginning in June 2014, Del Ray Artisans will partner with the Shirlington branch of the Arlington Public Library to present another GWW opportunity. Details are being worked out. This site may feature works from an existing show or have its own separate submission.
- This summer, another partnership between Del Ray Artisans, the Vola Lawson Animal Shelter, and the Animal Welfare League of Alexandria will offer members the opportunity to display animal-themed artwork at the shelter. Shelter renovations are planned this spring, so the timeline is still being worked out. Hopefully a GWW show will pop up there in August 2014.

Imani Russell, our community and business liaison, is seeking even more venues to showcase members' work. If you have ideas on possible venues, please contact Imani at Community@TheDelRayArtisans.org. We are looking for volunteer venue coordinators for each of the GWW sites. The time commitment for each venue will vary depending on length of shows, size of venue, and whether events are planned as part of the show.
