Boy Scouts and DRAngels Planted a Butterfly Garden on April 26

The Butterfly Garden is in! There are still a few plants to tuck in: dill and parsley along with milkweed are staples of Monarch life.

- ... Thanks to local Del Ray butterfly gardener Sue Tate who collected seeds for our garden last year, put them in the freezer which the seeds like, and started seedlings of two varieties of milkweed that she will bring by in May.
- Saturday, April 26 by writing a proposal, organizing the troop and laboring hard in DRA's yard. Compacted, rock and clay soil was attacked with vigour. David's mom, dad, and younger brother were on hand with about 15 boys and parents throughout the day. A beautiful lunch and snacks were provided by his family as were all the soil additions to lighten and enrich the new garden bed. Many thanks from Del Ray Artisans to the whole Ramotowski family!
- ... Marlin Lord's efforts with the park clean-up program has been a huge benefit to helping finance the purchase of the plants. Thanks Marlin!

More than 3-dozen plants from several nurseries include some natives, some just beneficial to the larvae, butterflies and bees. The garden will be appropriately weedy later in the season. Some deadheading (under advisement) will encourage more flowers. We hope all the plants will thrive and become the butterflies' feast we envision.

- ... Four posts along the front edge of the garden will support Crepe Myrtle cuttings we gathered when Dave Levy pruned the trees this past winter. Thanks Dave, for the wonderful job installing soaker hoses in the gardens this past year.
- ... Thanks to the Theatre Church volunteer group and to our core group of DRA volunteers, who have helped to revive our gardens and make them look inviting. I hope to entice them to help me construct the fence and replant the bird house on their Second Saturday Service Day. We have plans for signs and a banner for the chain fence. Walk around the gardens and see the changes! There are more perennials to plant in the mature part of the garden, some pruning and mulching to do and always weeding! Put a Bird on It!

Call for Entry | Del Ray Artisans Gallery | September 5 – 28, 2014

On the TV show Portlandia, Carrie and Fred spoofed art and design when they descended on a home décor shop and embellished everything in sight with a bird motif. "Put a Bird on It!" they squealed, slapping birds on bags, pillows, artworks, and pottery. This quickly became a catch phrase for over-used, over-embellished DIY design.

This Del Ray Artisans show sets out to prove that embellishment can be art. Channel your inner Duchamp, your inner Jasper Johns, your inner Bird! Jurors are Laura Perritt, Architect Emeritus, printmaker, and fiber/mixed media artist and Mikeual Perritt, Architect Emeritus, printmaker, and photographer.

Embellish everyday objects, recycled items, or even your own artwork, to transform them into new soaring pieces. But, you must remain true to the theme: all artwork must incorporate a 'bird', either thematically or literally. Let your imagination fly high with the 'Bird'. Put a Bird on It!, indeed!

Show Entry Details:

- Receiving: Sunday, August 31, 6:00 8:00 pm and Monday, September 1, 6:00 8:00 pm.
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$5 per piece for members; \$10 per piece for non-members.
- Artworks must be ready to hang or display with wire and screw eyes, mounting and/or display stand, framed, matted, or with edges finished. Work that is not ready for exhibition will not be accepted. See www.TheDelRayArtisans.org/shows/artguidelines.html for details.
- Artists are asked to make a 20% donation (tax-deductible) to Del Ray Artisans for sold works, both in Show and Marketplace.

Marketplace Entry Details:

- Artists must have submitted at least one entry for the show to participate in the Birds Nest Marketplace.
- Each artist may submit up to 6 entries. Entry fee is \$10 for up to 6 entries for members; \$20 for up to 6 entries for non-members.
- Marketplace entries will be displayed as space allows and at curators' discretion. Sold items may be restocked.
- Each Marketplace entry must be tagged with title, media, price, and artist name. Work may be fine handcrafts or shrink-wrapped 2D art (no larger than 18"x24") for cash-and-carry sales. Works must be for sale.

Accepted Artist Requirements:

- Artists are responsible for drop-off/pick-up arrangements.
- All artists MUST gallery host and/or volunteer with set-up, hanging, opening/closing receptions and/or take down. Bring your calendars to sign up for duties at receiving. Artists are asked to contribute a food or beverage for the opening reception.
- Entry fees are not refundable.
- Insurance for artwork is the responsibility of the artist. Neither Del Ray Artisans nor the City of Alexandria can be held liable for any loss or damage.
- Permission to photograph any work for publicity purposes is automatically granted by the artist as a requisite for entering the show.
- Work must be original (no reproductions) and not previously exhibited in a Del Ray Artisans show.
- Any artwork left over 30 days after the close of the show will become property of Del Ray Artisans.
- Print out and keep a copy of both sides of this form for your records.
