From the President

October 20, 2014

As you may know, I'm stepping down from my role as DRA President at the end of this year. I've served on the DRA Board for 7 years, starting as Director of Curating and then as your President. It is time for new leadership. Given the breadth and depth of skills, knowledge and experience among our membership and newly elected 2015 Board, I know our organization will be in good hands.

In 2015 you'll be seeing some new Board members, but there will be old hands to retain our organizational history and make transitions smooth. As Immediate Past President, I'll still be available to the Board as an advisor during 2015.

Since I joined the Board in 2008, much has changed. The time and dedication given to DRA by our Board and a few "uber" volunteers is reflected in the many new programs and activities that keep the gallery busy virtually every day and night of the week. I'm proud to be a witness to DRA's artistic growth. Here are some examples of that growth:

- Exciting monthly exhibits now bring in needed funds for DRA through entry fees and art sales and draw gallery visitors and new members. Our Gallery Without Walls program, which displays members' art in off-site locations, has grown to three rotating exhibition sites. More venues are possible we just need additional volunteers to coordinate them!
- Life Drawing grew from a single weekend session to several sessions each week while programs like Partners in Art and SocialLights offer support and artistic growth to interested members. We've experimented with unusual events such as Speed Dating that introduce new audiences to DRA. We also offer a variety of outreach activities and events each year for artists and the community.
- Our annual High School Art Exhibit is so successful that other student art programs have applied to participate. We've started planning an expansion of the student art exhibit and will move ahead with new programming in 2015. The long-established children's Art Camp is now under professional leadership and has expanded to two weeks each summer. Our newest summer program, Grown-Ups Art Camp, had a successful second season.
- We've been creative in raising money to help support exhibits and other programs despite the fact the Board's fundraiser position has been vacant for several years. The annual yard sale, a partnership with the Little Theater of Alexandria this past June and mini-fundraisers held in conjunction with several of our exhibits bring in major funds.

DRA's challenge for the coming years will be to maintain the current level of programming. We cannot continue the quality and quantity of exhibits and activities without increased participation from our membership. About 25-30 members (including the Board) are responsible for planning and implementing most of what we do each year. It is unfair and unsustainable to depend on a handful of volunteers to make things happen for everyone else. So, fellow DRA members, how will you contribute to keep DRA running?

Most members do not meet the required 12 volunteer hours per year — one hour a month! If you can't volunteer, consider making a tax-deductible contribution to provide funds to hire paid staff to aid overworked volunteers. Go to our web site (www.TheDelRayArtisans.org) and click on "Donate" or "Join/Renew" in the top right corner for more information.

By any standard, DRA is a successful volunteer arts organization. It has been an honor serving on the DRA Board.
