## **Building Bridges** Exhibit runs June 5-28

**Opening Reception:** Friday, June 5 from 7-9pm

Bridges bring together places, people, and cultures. As a juried collaboration between Del Ray Artisans and Six Degrees Consortium, Building Bridges once again brings together Del Ray Artisans (DRA)

artists and invited Mississippi Gulf Coast artists.

Hurricane Katrina first bridged these groups 10 years ago when DRA members provided support to their fellow artists who had lost everything.

Using any medium, artists were asked to thematically or literally interpret the importance of building bridges between people and cultures in our ever-shrinking world. This show is the vision of guest Curator Lori K. Gordon, a visual artist, who is the Founder and President of Six Degrees Consortium. Ms. Gordon was one of the original bridges between Alexandria and the Gulf Coast, and she has remained a friend to DRA ever since. During the opening reception on Friday, June 6 from 7-9 pm, curators Linda Elliff, Barb Boatman, and Lori Gordon will recognize artists whose work best interprets the theme.

## First Thursday: "Bridging Worlds" Artist Talk

During "Bridging Worlds" on Thursday, June 5 at 7pm, Lori K. Gordon will talk about how her experience as a Katrina survivor artist led her to found Six Degrees Consortium. She will also discuss her journey from Mississippi to Morocco, where her newest venture is the recent opening of Marrakech Henna Art Café, which also serves as an exhibit space for local Moroccan artists. Ms. Gordon is a visual artist, writer, and photographer dedicated to the idea that visual art can be a powerful means of education and cross-cultural understanding. Six Degrees Consortium is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization dedicated to the creation and dissemination of socially significant visual art. Registration is not required for this free event, and Mississippi and Moroccan inspired refreshments will be served.

*Building Bridges* is a juried show between Del Ray Artisans and Six Degrees Consortium open to Del Ray Artisans (DRA) members and invited Mississippi Gulf Coast artists.

Building bridges between cultures is increasingly important in our ever-shrinking world. Empathy and understanding become possible when one individual reaches across cultural barriers to touch another person's life in some meaningful way. Artists entering this show are asked to visually interpret the building of bridges between peoples and cultures. Imagine a meeting between a peace activist and a refugee; a conversation between peoples of different religions; a playground filled with children from different countries. Artists may interpret this concept either thematically or literally in any medium.

Guest curator Lori K. Gordon is a visual artist, writer, Founder and President of Six Degrees Consortium, a Mississippibased 501(c) 3 organization dedicated to the creation and dissemination of socially significant visual art. The Consortium is dedicated to the idea that visual art can be a powerful means of education and cross-cultural understanding. Ms. Gordon also envisions *Building Bridges* as recognition of Del Ray Artisans' member assistance to Mississippi artists following Hurricane Katrina, which devastated the Mississippi Gulf Coast 10 years ago.

- Sales: All received art must be for sale. Artists are asked to make a 20% tax-deductible donation to be split between Del Ray Artisans and Six Degrees Consortium when art is sold.
- Pick Up of Not Selected Art: Any art not selected must be picked up at the gallery on June 3 from 6-8pm.
- **Pick Up of Unsold Art:** Any art left over 30 days after the close of the show will become the property of Del Ray Artisans.


