Important Information for Del Ray Artisans Members

To Del Ray Artisans members:

As first published in the September 2015 issue of *The Well-Crafted Word* newsletter, Del Ray Artisans' membership structure and fees will change on January 1, 2016.

The membership fees have not been changed in at least 6 years. Since that time, Del Ray Artisans (DRA) has greatly expanded its offerings and programs. After careful research of similar arts organizations in the area, the DRA Board of Directors determined that our membership structure and fees needed updating. On July 14, 2015, the Board approved revision of DRA's membership structure and fees to take effect January 1, 2016.

The biggest structure change is that the former "Household" category has split into "Dual" and "Family". For current "Household" members, if your membership is for two people, please renew in the "Dual" category; or renew in the "Family" category to accommodate two adults and up to four children. In both new categories, members must reside at the same address.
