# True Colors: Like a Rainbow January 8-31, 2016

Patrons will see a colorful display of creativity with each piece of art using three or more "true" colors from the rainbow. Come enjoy the artwork and mingle with artists and art appreciators during this unveiling of the exhibit. The show also features our ever-popular boutique with "art-to-go" and runs from January 8-31. In conjunction with the exhibit, four workshops are offered to brighten up your January:

- 1. Polymer Clay Workshop: Sunday, January 10, 1-5pm. Ken and Sue Reed share their knowledge of polymer clay techniques using a "rainbow" of colors! Students can execute a small jewelry or sculpture project.
- 2. Introduction to Wire Jewelry: Thursday, January 14, 7-9pm. Jewelry instructor Tamara Wilkerson takes us into the intricate and exciting world of wire jewelry. Experiment with different tools and wire sizes, while creating basic, colorful, and useful jewelry components. Go home with finished jewelry pieces.
- 3. Playing with Resin: Monday, January 18, 6:30-9:30pm. Learn how to use resin in your artwork! Instructor Tracy Wilkerson will show you how to "play" with resin in a safe environment and learn the ins and outs of mixing resin and using it—as an adhesive, a covering, or the main medium.
- 4. Secrets of the Paper Garden: Hand-dyed Paper Flowers: Sunday, January 24, 1-4pm. Artist Debbie Smith Mezzetta is back with a new recipe for colorful paper flowers using a unique paper—it's a secret (and conveniently available and inexpensive)! Come to class and find out! Students will learn easy and fun techniques for hand-dying and creating everlasting flowers from the "secret" ingredient—psst, it goes great with coffee!

# All aBoard Exhibit is "Comin Round the Bend" February 5-28, 2016

Opening Reception: Friday, February 5, 7-9pm

All aBoard!—for art, that is! DRA presents an exhibit showcasing the unique art of eight talented members of the Board of Directors. This art train begins its journey around the gallery with an opening reception on Friday, February 5 from 7-9pm. Mingle with the artists, exchange ideas, and have a fun and interesting evening!

At the opening and throughout February, art patrons may stop and view the unique hand-crafted wood constructions of Ron Blank; nature-inspired landscape and abstract paintings of Michele Reday Cook; and magical



illumination of **Kim S. Joy**'s stained glass. The journey continues with a view of **Stephen Lally**'s organic pottery; **Marlin Lord**'s representational photography and artwork; and **Elizabeth Guerry Mead**'s fused and cold-worked glass. And don't miss the creative mixed media work of **Kathy Turner**, who uses texture and the illusion of motion in her work, and brilliantly colored photographs of **Joan Woodill**. What a dazzling panoply of art!

Board members also invite patrons to take the artwork at time of purchase! *All aBoard* runs from February 5-28, 2016.

# November Under \$100 Exhibit: by the numbers

- 73 artists submitted work.
- 235 pieces were displayed in the gallery.
- 153 additional pieces were placed in the 'boutique' alcove or the flat artwork bins. That made a total of 388 pieces. Of those pieces, 47 of them were brought in during the second drop off held halfway through the exhibit.
- The exhibit opened on November 6. By November 8, 52 pieces had sold; by November 16, 64 had sold, and by November 22, 88 had sold

- During the Black Friday shopping reception, Kurt Peterson made the 100th sale of the show, and by the close of the show on Nov. 29, 123 pieces had sold. That means 31.5% of the show sold.
- Five artists sold more than six pieces each, with one artist selling 10 pieces.
- 46 artists received payment checks for selling work. Sales totals for the show were over \$8,000.

I am utterly astonished and humbled by the success and final numbers of this show. Thanks to all artists who entered work, patrons who bought work, a volunteer who helped hang work, my co-curating team members (Gordon Frank, Maria Illingworth, and Kurt Peterson) who helped jury and run the show, and the many gallery hosts who kept the doors open during this show.

I am truly grateful, and it was gratifying to hear from SO many people, that this kind of "affordable art show" would be welcome again at DRA. —Stacy Rausch, Curator

# VCA Alexandria Animal Hospital Art Show ends January 31!
