Several critical Board positions are open and we need you to fill them. As a Board member, each of these Directors has a voice and vote on all things discussed at Board meetings. - The **Programs Director** maintains the gallery's current programs and helps develop new ones for members and surrounding communities. Duties include reading and responding to emails, helping develop program proposals, drafting publicity documents, and coordinating schedules as they relate to ongoing and future art exhibits. ## What's this thing called—Plein Air Painting?

Plein air painting is the making of art on site—painting what you see. Usually done outdoors, it captures the ephemeral light of a passing day. Painted quickly, or over a series of days at the same time of day, the painter captures the essence of time and place. Traditionally, plein air pictures were studies for studio final works. Nowadays, the plein air piece is the final product. In the last 10 years, plein air festivals, paint outs, and competitions have exploded across the country.

The painter is portable with pochade box or Julian easel, supplies in bag or backpack, small panels, and an umbrella. Check out the artists participating in this First Thursday's "Paint Del Ray" event (June 2)! This is plein air in action.

# FUN-derful is Two Shows in One this August!

How can that be? TWO shows? Yes!!! The first attraction ("Main Show") is called *FUN-derful*. This is Witty, Punny, Wacky, Schticky, Colorful, Silly, Zany, Quirky, Comical, Humorous and just LOL FUN art. Lookie! Lookie! Show runs August 5-28, 2016 at the gallery.

The second is a mini-FUN-raiser called: "Can You Spare a Square?" Artists adopt matboard squares and donate completed 6" x 6" artworks to DRA to support the gallery. Paint, Draw, Collage, Fiber, Photo, Assemblage, Mix and anything creative. The completed squares will be sold at a set price with prizes awarded to Squares for this affordable FUN-raiser.

Artists are encouraged to stop by the gallery during open hours and pick up some Squares with show details. FUN curator Karen Schmitz invites all area artists to participate in the merriment. #### Fire and Earth

Fire and earth are two of the four elements. The September exhibit celebrates these elements in a hybrid show that combines a national ceramic cup exhibit with a regional 2-D exhibit. The exhibit will honor how fire in the kiln (be it fueled by wood, gas, or electricity) transforms earth (clay) into functional drinking vessels (cups, mugs, tankards, tumblers, goblets, & tea bowls).

Entry to this exhibit is by online submission. The 3-D Ceramic Cup entries are due by midnight on Saturday, July 30. The 2-D Exhibit entries are due by midnight on Saturday, August 13. Details and entry forms at: TheDelRayArtisans.org/CFE
