The "Creating Collage Papers from Coffee Filters and Alcohol Inks" workshop with Mary Kralj is on Monday, December 4 from 10 am—noon. Each participant will take home: a set of 3 or more alcohol inks created in class along with instructions for how to create more at home, a set of papers of various sizes created from custom dyed and painted coffee filters, with instructions for how to create more at home, and a sample of coffee filters from fellow classmates to demonstrate the variability that can be achieved with this technique. Del Ray Artisans' 25th Anniversary Year has been jam packed with fun and exciting events, opportunities to give back to the community, and promising plans for the future. It has been a rewarding year for DRA, thanks to key 25th Anniversary Committee members who have given their time to make this year successful.

No 25th year would be complete without a 25th Anniversary logo. Nancy Flores got us off to a grand start by designing our 25th logo. It has been used on programs, letters, the website, and T-shirts designed by Cameron Turner and Josh Oliveira. We are grateful to Nancy, Cameron and Josh for their artistic talents.

Our March 25th Anniversary Reception officially began the year-long celebration. Huge thanks go to Michele Reday Cook for presenting a grand reception honoring DRA's Founding Members and recognizing Alexandria city officials, local and state officials, and local and state arts commission members. The large crowd in attendance enjoyed bounteous food featuring recipes from the DRA cookbook.

A most important area of any organization's budget is fundraising, and Brandy Lellou has ably led the 25th Anniversary Fundraising effort. At this writing, local businesses have donated \$3800 and more given as 'in kind' contributions. Just over \$3,000 has been raised through sales of Silver Stars. Barbara Boehm is spearheading the 25th Anniversary Silver Legacy Project to use a portion of the Silver Star purchases to provide selected Alexandria Public Schools who have art needs with art-related books and instructional materials. DRA Fundraising Director Joe Franklin pitched in to help with this fundraising endeavor. Jenny Nicholson's beautiful hand lettering on a plaque designed by Karen Schmitz provides recognition to all of the Corporate Supporters. "A Big Bucks Thank You" to all of them.

Angela Calos and John Bordner organized a wonderful evening collaborating with The Little Theatre of Alexandria and we thank them for making it part of the 25th Celebration. "Red, White, and Tuna" was a fun, zany production accompanied by marvelous foods and a classy art raffle.

As founding members themselves, Kathryn Brown and Marlin Lord have provided us with their historical knowledge for the last 25 years. They have served throughout the years in numerous Board positions, working to preserve the organization. Kathryn has completed a revised, more comprehensive history of Del Ray Artisans. Our history recalls how DRA became known for its Offbeat Auctions. Chairman Kurt Peterson gathered donations and planned a modern "twisted" version of those past DRA auctions.
