

Entries due: Monday, February 12, 2018

Art and nature have been closely linked from the time of cave drawings. Before the camera was in common usage, what we learned about the nature of things and our environment came largely through the work of artists. Scientists, explorers and adventurers all recorded animals, vegetation, and landscapes in their visual records.

Outdoors In is an exhibition about how artists see nature and depict it in painting, sculpture, textiles, found materials, and drawing. This show is for Del Ray Artisans members and all local area high school and college students. Students are not required to pay an entry fee. Outdoors In will award cash prizes for the top selected entries: \$100 for best in show, \$50 for second place, and \$25 for honorable mention.

Big Developments for Gallery Without Walls

• Gallery Without Walls (GWW) returns to VCA Alexandria Animal Hospital. After a six-month hiatus, Del Ray Artisans artwork will once again grace the walls of the VCA Alexandria Animal Hospital (located at 2660 Duke St.). The animal hospital just completed a major renovation, working with the strong bones of their original structure to reinvent the hospital to better serve their clients.

The title of our next Gallery Without Walls show is *Reinvention*. DRA members are challenged to look at the "bones" of a prior piece and reinvent it with a new message/color scheme or to reinvent themselves as artists by working in a medium outside their comfort zone.

This members-only show is a great opportunity, since we have had a large number of sales at the animal hospital, and there are no entry fees. The show will run from March 4 through June 10, 2018 and digital submissions are due February 26, 2018. (As with other GWW shows at the animal hospital, when art sells, each artist is asked to make a 20% tax-deductible donation, 10% to Veterans Moving Forward and 10% to Del Ray Artisans.) • Durant Arts Center show is up until February 26. Del Ray Artisans is proud to showcase the artwork of more than 50 members in a Gallery Without Walls show at the Durant Arts Center (located at 1605 Cameron St. in Alexandria) through February 26, 2018. With more than 130 entries to choose from, curators Drew Cariaso and Eileen O'Brien were able to pull together a very interesting show with an open theme.

A sizeable crowd braved the cold to attend the opening reception (see pictures below), held on Monday, December 11, 2017. Patrons may view the artwork at the center from 5pm to 9pm Monday through Friday, or during the business hours of Upcycle Creative Reuse center (see upcyclecrc.org).
