## Adopt-a-Park Gears Up For Another Year

We have entered into a new year for the Adopt-a-Park and have agreed to adopt the Colasanto Park and building again. We had a successful year in 2017 and raised over \$750 for DRA. If you want to try your hand at improving the appearance of the gallery and the surrounding parkland, get a little fresh air and get exercise and also get credit towards your required volunteer time (see the article below for instructions on how to report volunteer time online), please consider volunteering for this program. We have been doing Adopt-a-Park for about 13-14 years. In previous years we have earned over \$800 per year for DRA. The money goes towards our award-winning landscaping and improvements around the gallery as well as going towards other expenses.

The Adopt-a-Park program runs from April 1 - November 30; we pick up trash and debris around the gallery and in the adjoining Colasanto Park. We usually do this work in an hour or less on Sundays since inspections by the Recreation Department staff are on Mondays. We pick up from the intersection of Mount Vernon and Commonwealth Avenues south to the fence adjacent to the school play field. The city has a point schedule which deducts points for any trash found during the inspections.
