Call for Entry for *Eat*, *Drink*, *and* Be Merry September 7–30, 2018 Ceramic entries due: Sunday, August 5, 2018 Non-ceramic entries: Sunday, August 19, 2018

Eat, Drink, and Be Merry celebrates the way that food and drink bring joy to our lives. Artwork should be inspired by food, real or metaphorical that nourishes the viewer. Artists may also highlight the rituals and places that celebrate the social gathering around sustenance. *Eat, Drink, and Be Merry* is a hybrid show that combines



a national ceramic show (open to all U.S. artists) focused on vessels for the dining table and food with a regional non-ceramic two- and three-dimensional show (open to all area artists) that echoes these themes.

Symmetry Call for Entry October 5-28, 2018 Digital entries due: Sunday, August 26, 2018

Del Ray Artisans and Union 206 Studio are seeking fine art photography that showcases artists' visions of symmetry. Symmetry implies a sense of aesthetically pleasing proportionality. Balanced composition can be symmetrical, asymmetrical, or radical where the various elements that make up the image –



shapes, colors, texture, and space – are arranged with care to create a harmonious result. Art pieces will demonstrate careful staging, composition and lighting of the subject, as well as thoughtful post-processing techniques (if desired) and selection of material to make an individual expression.

- Local events by business or community associations, where volunteers set up booths or tents, host, and educate people about DRA. Examples: Art on the Avenue, First Thursdays
- Curate or co-curate a show. Shows also need extra help such as gallery hosting, receiving and pickup, hanging art, managing Art-to-Go
- Post DRA events and opportunities to social media (Facebook, Twitter) and well as local arts websites, communicate with local publications about DRA activities
- Coordinate and support ongoing programs like Partners in Art
- Office assistance tasks, Gardening tasks, Adopt-a-Park
- Work for DRA annual programs like Spring Market, Holiday Market, GUAC, Youth Art Camps
- Del Ray Business Association First Thursday events need people to coordinate, work, cleanup, and host extended gallery hours.
- Kitchen Crew: cleaning up and organizing the kitchen on a monthly basis
- Craft Closet: planning and organizing the craft closet, especially before and after camps
- Volunteer Team: generate ideas and support and recruit new volunteers

Grown-Ups Art Camp - Another Successful Year

This year, nearly 90 participants signed up for 15 classes/workshops held over 10 days from June 30-July 13. More than 35 students enrolled this year were nonmembers. Planning for a program as big as Grown-Ups Art Camp starts in January and continues until after camp is over. In the next few months we will be reviewing both student and instructor survey responses to help us better understand and shape our summer program offerings. Thanks to all who attended classes and shared your thoughts with us by filling out evaluation forms.
