DRA's Got Sunshine!





Grown-Ups Art Camp Expands to Become Summer Intensive Program

There are changes on the horizon for Grown-Ups Art Camp (GUAC). After reviewing feedback from previous years' participants, instructors, volunteers and staff, the Board has decided to make some big, positive changes to the program. Instead of GUAC occurring only during the first two weeks of July, we will offer more workshops, programs, and talks during the summer months of June, July, and August under the umbrella of this program.

We are expanding the program for the following reasons:

- By spreading out the workshops over the summer students can potentially take MORE workshops, because it will be easier to plan work schedules and budget. (Plus you can take that Independence Day trip and still have workshops to choose from!)
- Some of the two-week period that formerly was GUAC will be used for a "to be determined" project focusing on our mission and benefiting the community. Ideally during part of this time frame, we should still be able to use the gallery for "messy" classes not possible when the gallery has artwork on the walls.
- Instructors won't have to compete with each other for limited time slots.
- Instructors could potentially teach the same workshop more than once during the summer for classes that fill up fast, have a small registration cap, or are popular, it would be great to have this as an option.
- Classes can start being booked now, and I will work with curators of the June
 and August exhibits to incorporate as many classes as we can to coincide with
 the theme of that month's show.
- The expanded time frame will also allow for ongoing programs like Life Drawing to be included in the advertising.

We are changing the name "GUAC" – though it is catchy, it is confusing to people outside our organization. Since one of our goals is to reach a broader audience, we need to target non-members with a concise, clear message about the program.
