Portraits of Progress at Principle Gallery Old Town



On Tuesday, April 2 from 6–8pm at Principle Gallery, 208 King Street in Alexandria, join the Friends of Guest House for *Portraits of Progress*, an exhibition of artwork by formerly incarcerated women. Free admission. This organization is supported by DRA member Kelli Sincock and her Inspiration Matterz program, which teaches art to inmates at Alexandria and Fairfax Detention Centers as well as at the Guest House. DRA supports Inspiration Matterz.

Friends of Guest House helps women successfully reenter the community from incarceration. Since 1974, Guest House has helped more than 3,000 women break the vicious cycle of incarceration, reunite with their families, and reintegrate into their communities.

Volunteer Opportunities: Spirit Nights at McDonald's

The Mateos family owns several McDonald's restaurants and has invited Del Ray Artisans to be one of their Community Partners, which means we will have the opportunity to conduct a "Spirit Night" once a month. For a three-hour period we can display our members' art inside the McDonald's at 1000 North Henry St. Members will interface with the customers and talk about the art on display,



DRA, and our gallery. We need at least four volunteers to greet customers and hand out food. The McDonald's staff will prepare the food, take orders and money. McDonald's Spirit Nights will take place from 4–7pm on Thursday, April 25; Thursday, May 16; Thursday, June 20; Thursday, September 19; and Thursday, October 3. Upcoming Workshops Introduction to Acrylic Painting Workshop Saturday, March 9, I-4pm

Introduction to Acrylic Painting will cover the basic principles for working with acrylic paints. Topics include:

- Paint selection, palettes, brushes, mediums, painting surfaces, tools
- Unique acrylic properties
- Surface preparation
- Mixing colors
- Using mediums
- Acrylics vs oils
- Acrylic palette and brushes



Participants will perform some basic color, shade, and tint mixing.
