Artwork Receiving Procedure: A Few Changes

If you've had artwork in any recent exhibits, you may have noticed that we've made a few changes to the process. Here's how the improved procedure works:

- Station One (NEW): DRA representative checks hanging requirements.
- Station Two: Artists pick up and affix temporary artwork tag(s).
- Station Three: Artists check membership and pay any exhibit/Art-to-Go fees. DRA representative reviews/approves Art-to-Go entries.
- Station Four: Artists sign up for the required three-hour volunteer shift.
- Station Five (NEW): Artists fill out Art-To-Go tags, if necessary. (Artists also have the option of filling out Art-To-Go tags online and printing the tags at home. If you are accepted into an exhibit, the curator will send a link to the online form to do this step before you come to the gallery for drop-off.)

Interview with Joyce Frank, Curator of Art in Meditation

What exactly are the chakras?

"Chakra" means "wheel" in Sanskrit and you can think of the chakras as seven wheels of energy in the body. Each chakra has a symbol associated with it, and a color, and each has a different spiritual focus. There is a chart explaining the chakras posted on the DRA website, and we will have it available as a handout during the show. Our own Nancy Ramsey will present a workshop on painting the chakra energies and David Kosar of the yoga community also plans a workshop.

What made you think of doing a show about the chakras?

I know how active both the arts and yoga communities are in Del Ray and I thought it would be nice to have an exhibit that would bring them together. I love the idea of doing a meditation surrounded by art of the chakras.

There are several workshops planned to do that – a gong sound meditation with Monique Durfuss, a chair yoga meditation with Kay Sidahmed and a breath and sound meditation with Dante Baker.

Tell us about the other events you have planned for the show.

We will have an opening reception on June 7 and another reception on June 21 to celebrate the summer solstice and the Well Ray event the next day.

We plan to have booths at First Thursday and Well Ray with chakra-themed art for sale, and we will also have an "art-to-go" market in the gallery for the run of the show.

We're looking forward to an exciting month and hope you can join us!
