
# Youth Art Camp Begins Monday, July 15

# The 2 Sides Project, Special Edition: Exhibit and Film at Del Ray Artisans Gallery, July 11-14, 2019 Reception: Friday, July 12, 7-9pm

The 2 Sides Project documents the connection of sons and daughters whose fathers were killed on opposite sides of the Vietnam War, through photographs and film. A dozen Gold Star Americans have now met face-to-face with more than 60 Vietnamese sons and daughters, and the story of their first meeting has been featured in an award-winning documentary film. Anthony Istrico and his team are exhibiting still photos and stories from their Vietnam experiences in Del Ray Artisans' gallery from July 11 - July 14, 2019, along with two showings of the documentary film. Showings, followed by Q & A, are: PBS version (56 minutes) on Saturday, July 13 from 7–8:30pm; Feature-length film (101 minutes) on Sunday, July 14 from 2–4pm.
