

Kondo vs. Chaos examines two versions of "stuff":
1) the Marie Kondo minimizing theory where you only keep the things that bring you joy, and where everything is precisely ordered and 2) the chaos reality in which there is no order. Followers of chaos may be people who "think outside the box" or don't see "the box". Artists may integrate one or both aspects.
